As I sit back and “ponder” on the events of these past few weeks, one word comes to mind...WOW!

WOW! What a storm! In my 50 years on this earth, I have seen the fury of nature many times... the blizzard of 1978, the flood of 1998, the ice

WOW! This was big...three-quarters of our members were without power. Poles and wire were down all over our nine-county service territory. Six of our substations were down as the AEP transmission lines that bring power from the Cardinal Plant were damaged. Our linemen were out in the storm trying to assess the damages...other employees were in the office dealing with the chaos...all working together to get the lights back on. It almost seemed hopeless...but we never lost hope.

WOW! Our neighboring co-ops from Ohio, Pennsylvania and Kentucky answered our calls for help and sent crews to aid in the restoration. We are indeed a cooperative family and this family stretches across state lines. Thank you!

WOW! The heat...it was almost unbearable...dangerous. Our employees and our members struggled through the worst week of heat and oppressive humidity that I can ever remember. But slowly...the lights began to come back on. After around eight days of misery, our work was done...but not quite. The power was “on” but the clean-up was just beginning; weeks of work were waiting.

WOW! What a pain in the behind! Sometimes I take electricity for granted... not realizing how much of a “necessity” it is in my everyday life. Without it...no water, no AC, no lights, no refrigerator...miserable! I cheered out loud when the lights came back on at my house after seven days.

WOW! THANK YOU MEMBERS...for your patience and understanding during this terrible event...the worst in our history. I know that it was a difficult week for many of you...it was for us too. I won't apologize for the length of the outages...instead, I applaud our employees and the effort that each and every one of them gave...that type of effort brings one word to mind...WOW!

## How can my electric use be up?

Even though you are reading this in September, I am writing it in late July. I can already anticipate the calls that will come in August as members get bills for their June 15 to July 15 electricity consumption. The question will be, "How can my electric use be up when my power was off for three to eight days? This can't be possible"...or can it?

It is not only possible, but probable. It is true for myself as well. Our power was off for four days or about 13 percent of a month; yet our electric use was 1,828 kWh compared to 1,282 kWh for the previous month and we read the religiously on the 15th of every month. How could we use 42 percent more electric when the power was off for 13 percent of the month? Very easily.

"Let me count the ways," is the old saying. Everyone's circumstances are different but most are similar. When the power came back on, many appliances

worked overtime to catch up like freezers, refrigerators and water heaters. And let's not forget that huge pile of laundry that built up to be washed and dried. "But that would not raise the bill because it would have been done anyway," you would say. And I totally agree, this would not increase your consumption, but it would defer some to when power was restored.

The real reason for the increase is a simple subject of cooling degree days (CDD). A CDD is each degree difference between the day's average temperature and 65 degrees. For example, if the day's average is 75 degrees, then that day would accrue 10 CDD. This is the best way to measure the amount of cooling load (and power) that is required to keep our home or business comfortable. We all know that the past two summers have been hot, but do you realize just how much so? The last time we had this much heat was 1999.

Now to answer the question of increased electric use with the power out several days. The average CDD for July 2007 to 2010 was 290. This year will be very close to last year at about 478. If your power was out for seven days and on for 22 days, that would be on for 77 percent of the month. 77 percent multiplied by 478 CDD is 368 CDD. That is still 27 percent more CDD than the previous four-year average of 290, and therefore 27 percent more electric use.

I have tried to simplify what seems to be complicated numbers. But I do know that my central air uses about 33 cents every hour it is running. It did not run for several days, my bill was up and it would have been higher had I not lost power. I would have gladly traded a higher electric bill with AC for the sweltering days I had no air, and a much higher gasoline bill to run a generator (that was too small to run the air conditioner).

### OFFICIAL NOTICE MEDICAL CERTIFICATION

Medical certification forms are available upon request at Guernsey-Muskingum Electric Cooperative, Inc., office for those persons who must certify that disconnection of electric service would make the operation of necessary medical equipment impossible or impracticable, or that such discontinuation of electric service would otherwise be dangerous to the health and welfare of persons residing in the household.

In all cases where discontinuation of service would be especially dangerous to life and welfare of the occupants within a household, the consumer should contact the cooperative and request a "Medical Certification" form. This form must then be completed and certified by a licensed physician or local board of health and filed with the cooperative.

## Stealing electricity and meter tampering are crimes

Since August 1978, a revised Ohio law has been in effect covering theft of utility service and tampering with utility equipment. The statute provides that a person does not have to be seen tampering with a meter to be held responsible for such action. Prior to the revision in the law, it was difficult to prosecute a person for meter tampering unless the action was witnessed.

In addition, in prosecution for a user's reconnecting a device that was disconnected by a utility, such activity now is considered prima facie evidence that the user intended to defraud the utility.

The law defines theft of a utility service as a first-degree misdemeanor if the value of the stolen electricity, plus any utility equipment repair, is less than \$150. It's a fourth-degree felony if the value is more than \$150 or if the offender was previously convicted of the charge. Tampering convictions carry similar penalties.

Tampering is defined "to interfere with, damage or bypass a utility meter, conduit or attachment with intent to impede the correct registration of a meter or the proper function of a conduit or attachments."

Conviction can bring from six months in jail and a \$1,000 fine to five years in jail and a \$2,500 fine.

Meter tampering costs all of us. It costs the cooperative, and it costs you. And it's downright dangerous. If you witness someone tampering with an electric meter, contact your cooperative office. Stealing electricity is a crime, and anyone caught violating the law will be prosecuted.

**Certification of Active Duty Deployment**  
**Guernsey-Muskingum Electric Cooperative, Inc.**

The cooperative will not disconnect electric service to the residential premises of any residential member who is deployed on active duty for nonpayment for electricity provided to the residential premises.

Upon return of the residential member from active duty, the cooperative will offer the residential member a period equal to at least the period of deployment on active duty to pay any arrearages incurred during the period of deployment. If the period the cooperative offers the residential member for repayment presents a hardship, the member may request a longer period to repay the arrearages. No late payment fees or interest will be charged to the residential member during the period of deployment or the repayment period.

“Active duty” means active duty pursuant to an executive order of the president of the United States, an act of the congress of the United States, or section 5919.29 or 5923.21 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The residential member must resume the timely payment of all charges for electric service provided by the cooperative after the return from active duty deployment.

In order to avoid disconnection of electric service for nonpayment for electric service during a period of active duty deployment, a completed Certification of Active Duty Deployment form must be submitted to the cooperative. Certification of Active Duty Deployment forms are available from the cooperative upon request.
